Building Act 1993 Part 7 – Protection of adjoining property
Adjoining property owners details

Council’s Property Ownership Details are considered as personal information under Victoria’s *Information Privacy Act 2000*. Property Ownership Details will only be made available to an applicant applying for a building permit where the building surveyor requires protection work notices to be served on the adjoining owner/s

Applicants to whom property ownership details information is made available must make written assurance that all information gained will be handled securely and will only be used in conjunction with Part 7 of the Building Act.
