7.1 PETITION TO PERMANENTLY RETAIN EXTENDED FOOTPATH TRADING AREAS AND SPACELETS IN MELROSE STREET, SANDRINGHAM AND CLOSE EAST END OF MELROSE STREET TO TRAFFIC
