Events and Festivals Grants

- Applications open year-round
- Funds of up to \$1000 per organisation per financial year
- Available for events and festivals held in Bayside and/or for the benefit of the wider Bayside community (not for members only)









Grant Eligibility

To be considered eligible, applicants must:

- \checkmark be a not for profit organisation
- ✓ have current, valid public liability insurance in place
- have successfully acquitted all previously funded Bayside City Council grants

Applicants that are not registered as not for profit groups may still apply if they are supported by an eligible auspice organisation.
